

3RVS Winter Route Map

This map was developed from a combination of various 3RVS touring routes and roads used throughout the winter on Show-N-Go rides. The red dots on this map indicate roads that are generally good for cycling although conditions may vary with regard to road surface and traffic volume. The goal was to have a handy reference for use on winter Show-N-Go rides in order to skirt around icy roads or shorten up a loop if weather changed or energy waned. For routes leaving from Homestead, Flaugh or Carroll there should be plenty of options to choose a loop that gives a tailwind for the return trip.

Print the map in color, put it in a plastic bag and tuck it in your jersey pocket. Be careful to use inks that will not run if they get wet from snow, sleet or sweat. Choose a route that fits your goals for the day and be brave and explore – you can always turn around and backtrack if necessary. Note there is no scale but generally with our squared off county roads each intersection is about a mile apart.
